### 2017 Club Event Supplementary Regulations

Events will be run in accordance with the clubs constitution and the following supplementary regulations:

- Racing classes will be run depending upon numbers and the discretion of the Clerk of Course or Club Captain on the day
- Classes may include: (Grade races - A,B,C etc.), Capacity Races (125,250, Open), Handicapped, Over 55s & Sidecars
- At the end of each club event, where conditions allow, there may be an all grades in race, which will be handicapped (or similar) at the starter's discretion
- Out of class riding will only be allowed at the approval of the Clerk of Course or Club Captain on the day
- Sidecars and solos will not be on the track at the same time
- Sidecars can be run at all events where numbers allow
- The above regulations may be altered at the discretion of the Clerk of Course
