2023 Club Event Supplementary Regulations

Events will be run in accordance with the clubs constitution and the following supplementary regulations

- Classes will be run depending upon numbers and the discretion of the Primary Official or Club Captain on the day
- Classes may include: (Grades - A,B,C etc), Capacity (125,250, Unlim.), Handicapped, Euro, British or Japanese Bikes, Over 55's and Sidecars.
- At the end of each club event, where conditions allow, classes may be combined, which will be handicapped (or similar) at the officials discretion
- Out of class riding will only be allowed at the approval of the Primary Official or Club Captain on the day
- Sidecars and solos not to be on the track at the same time
- Sidecars can be run at all events
- Evolution Class (Twin shock) to have drum brakes, air cooled engine and twin shocks/non-linkage suspension
- The above regulations may be altered at the discretion of the Primary Official
- Unless specifically stated otherwise by promoter, **Sign on:** 0800-0845, **Briefing:** 0900, On track after briefing
